

Bus Services Act 2017 Royal assent – 27 April 2017 Commencement – 27 June 2017

Allows for:

- **franchising** (re-regulation)
- partnerships('Enhanced Partnerships')



Scotland:

Transport (Scotland) Act 2019 Roval assent – 15 November 2019 Commencement – 4 December 2023 (four years late!)

Allows for:

- **franchising** (re-regulation)
- partnerships ('Bus Service Improvement Partnerships')
- local authority run services
 (publicly-owned buses)










































WE DESERVE BETTER BUSES


more ambitious approach, because the status quo has failed.

The current deregulated, fragmented and **privatised model of delivering bus services does not work for the people and communities of the West of Scotland**, which is a diverse area with a significant economy and large population. In many ways, the need for <u>the region's extensive Community Transport sector</u>, including 5 community-owned bus services, which plugs network gaps and addresses unmet transport needs, is evidence of this failure.


SPT'S CONSULTATION RESULTS - JUNE 2024 SUPPORT FOR BUS REFORM OPTIONS:





76% SUPPORT RE-REGULATION OF OUR BUSES


SPT'S CONSULTATION RESULTS - JUNE 2024 SUPPORT FOR BUS REFORM OPTIONS:

PE2116: Accelerate the implementation of bus franchising powers

Calling on the Scottish Parliament to urge the Scottish Government to improve the process for implementing the bus franchising powers contained in the Transport (Scotland) Act 2019 by:

- introducing, without delay, the regulations and statutory guidance required to give bus franchising powers full effect
- amending the 2019 Act to remove the requirement for proposed franchising frameworks to be approved by a panel appointed by the traffic commissioner, instead empowering Regional Transport Partnerships (RTPs) to have the final say on approving proposals
- providing additional funding to help support RTPs in preparing franchising frameworks and assisting them with initial set-up costs once frameworks are approved.
