
## About CT in England – Transport for Everyone



53% transport anyone in the community that has a barrier to transport – no age or mobility requirement

86% of the sector use section 19 permits

24% use section 22 permits – these are predominately in rural areas




86% utilise Volunteer Drivers

60% have 1-5 vehicles in their fleet

89% own or lease their own vehicles

9% currently have electric vehicles in their fleet



52% of the sector are primary purpose

Overall primary purpose organisations are small organisations – 57% under £100k
