Job Title:	Transport Co-ordinator
Location:	Based in Aberfeldy at the Locus Centre
Reports to:	Chair of Tay Valley Timebank
Hours of work:	24 hours per week in the first instance. There may be a possibility of additional hours once the post is established.
Salary	£14 per hour (PAYE) based on experience

Summary of Position:

Tay Valley Timebank as the 'parent company has established the Community Transport Hub in the Locus Centre, which is now integrated with Aberfeldy Information Centre functions. The successful candidate will be required to act as 'front of house' for the public and act as day to day co-ordinator of the Upper Tay Transport services, and provide holiday cover for the Hub Manager.

Key Tasks

Be the 'front of house' person for the public	Provide information about local services and provide information to local people and visitors. This post will complement the service provided in the AIC and appropriate training will be provided.
Run 'Community Lifts' on a day to day basis	Answer phones Link drivers and passengers Invoice for lifts and keep records Find and engage voluntary drivers.

Promote Active Travel	Take bookings for Active Travel sessions, guided bike rides and training sessions. Encourage use of local walking opportunities. This aspect of the service is currently under review but it is not expected that it will include checking bikes for loan or hire.	
Operate and develop other services run by UTT	UTT is the transport initiative developed by TVT for the community and is tasked to improve opportunities for local transport and will develop other initiatives in which you will be involved, and may be incorporated into your job description as the service develops.	
Promote Upper Tay Transport	To promote UTT when meeting people To prepare publicity material To maintain and keep website and database up to date To promote the service using social media.	
Provide reciprocal holiday cover for the Hub Manager	The successful candidate will be working in conjunction with the Hub Manager and provide cover for scheduled absences.
